Dear Friends,

Your Catholic Foundation enjoyed a record year in 2013 in many respects - overall donations to the Foundation, grants made into our community, and establishment of new donor funds, charitable trusts, and the addition of Legacy Circle members. Total assets were at \$175 million, contributions increased to \$25 million, investment returns on the unrestricted Philanthropy Fund were at 19.5%, and \$6.3 million was granted into our community. Thank you for your generosity to The Catholic Foundation!

During the year, Most Reverend Kevin Farrell, Bishop of the Diocese of Dallas, established a Designated Fund at the Foundation for the \$125 million Our Faith Our Future Capital Campaign. St. Gabriel Catholic Community and St. Anthony Catholic Community (Wylie) also set up Designated Funds at The Catholic Foundation for their combined local fundraising efforts and the Our Faith Our Future capital campaign, while other parishes are considering Foundation funds for their future needs.

Our philanthropy continues to cover a broad spectrum of needs at many charitable, religious and educational organizations. Our 2013 grants helped 10 diocesan schools update their technology (laptops, smart boards, and infrastructure); provided secure environments for three elementary schools; and 16 organizations were able to upgrade roofs, HVAC systems, windows, and parking lots. Legacy gifts from deceased donors provided tuition assistance enabling more than 100 students to attend our diocesan Catholic schools.

Thank you again to our existing donors and to those who have gone before us – your generosity and vision lives on in our community through The Catholic Foundation.

Continued explosive growth of our Catholic population in the Diocese of Dallas – now at 1.3 million – creates continued demand from our schools, churches, and other support organizations. On behalf of our donors, The Catholic Foundation awards grants in three main areas.



51.1% of our grants in 2013 went to educational causes, including grants to Franciscan University in Steubenville, Ohio; Bishop Dunne Catholic School in Dallas, Texas; Epiphany Quasi-Parish in Italy, Texas; and the Highlands School in Dallas, Texas, for needed renovations and improvements.



Religious 37.3%

37.3% of our grants in 2013 went to support religious causes including St. Mary's Catholic Church in Gainesville, Texas; the Benedictine Sisters in Jonesborough, Texas; and the Immaculate Conception Church of Corsicana, Texas, for renovations.



Charitable 11-6% Causes

11.6% of our grants in 2013 were awarded to charitable causes, including the Elderly Services Program at Catholic Charities; the Dallas chapter of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Fund; and Christian Community Action, a Lewisville, Texas, nonprofit dedicated to helping disadvantaged families with healthcare, nutritional and educational services.

In 2013, The Catholic Foundation awarded


