

More than ever, we are committed to our mission of promoting compassionate charitable giving and stewardship that serves donors and the needs of the Dallas-area Catholic community.

To all our donors who utilize The Catholic Foundation to assist in personal charitable efforts, thank you for your confidence.

We embrace the responsibility entrusted to us to carry out charitable intentions now, and for decades ahead. We exist because of donor generosity, and together, we form a strong foundation comprised of a deep and wide layer of supportive individuals.

On behalf of the Board of Trustees and staff, we're grateful for your support that fuels our vision to be the primary philanthropic leader whose trusted stewardship satisfies our donors' intentions while meeting the needs of the Catholic community.

We achieved significant accomplishments and new initiatives in 2018.

Through a grant from the unrestricted Philanthropy Fund, we enabled leadership teams from 50 parishes in the Catholic Diocese of Dallas to attend the Dallas/Fort Worth Amazing Parish Conference in April.

During the workshop-style format, pastors and parish leadership team members worked side-by-side to build a clear, practical vision of what leadership can look like at their parishes.

By their participation, the parish representatives received professional development involving operations, finance, business strategy and spiritual encouragement to make their parishes the best they can be to enhance our entire Catholic community.

We bolstered our unrestricted Philanthropy Fund last May by rebranding our Board Endowment Fund to The Gorman Society, named in honor of Bishop Thomas K. Gorman, the fourth bishop of the Diocese of Dallas and a founder of The Catholic Foundation. This permanent endowment exists to underwrite the operating expenses of the Foundation.

Through the Gorman Society, 100 percent of our Trustees, and many of our former Trustees, generously help safeguard the Foundation by providing for its future by contributing toward the endowment via current gifts and legacy gifts provided for in their wills.

To make it even easier and convenient to do business with us, we redesigned our website to be highly dynamic. The overhaul included the enhancement of DonorLink that makes it easy for donors to make charitable contributions to a fund and recommend grant distributions to qualified charities, check balances or review grant and giving history any time of day.

The fact that it is simple to give through the Catholic Foundation through online access as we work with, and alongside, donors to establish a charitable fund or make decisions about lifetime charitable giving is one of the things our donors most appreciate about us.

The grants we annually award from our Philanthropy Fund help our Dallas-area Catholic community with a wide-range of critical needs. Last year, our grants helped enhance facilities and infrastructure, introduced more technology in classrooms, enabled children to receive a quality Catholic education and more.

Thanks to the growing interest in the establishment of donor-advised funds for charitable and tax giving purposes, and the growing desire people have toward charitable giving, The Catholic Foundation achieved a strong performance in 2018 despite a rugged U.S. financial market.

At the end of 2018, the Foundation housed more than 440 charitable funds and trusts and managed approximately \$207 million in assets. An increased number of funds and trusts led to more parishes, schools and nonprofits receiving funding for substantial projects.



In 2018, the number of grants issued increased to more than 2,000 organizations totaling \$22.2 million, up from 1,800 grants totaling \$20.3 million in 2017.

The grants included our largest ever in the 64-year history of The Catholic Foundation as we and our Board of Trustees presented \$1.1 million to Holy Trinity Seminary to establish the Cardinal Farrell Student Center that will serve decades of young men on their journey to the priesthood.

We're blessed to witness the positive impact The Catholic Foundation continually makes in our community. And we look forward to working with you in the year ahead to build an even stronger foundation.
