

DEAR FRIENDS,

With appreciation to Catholic Foundation donors past and present, and in recognition of long-term relationships cultivated by the staff, 2019 was an outstanding year.

Thanks to donors who generously expressed their charitable vision in 2019, unrestricted and restricted contributions were in excess of \$27 million last year, a larger total contribution than 2018 and 2017 combined.

In terms of grants awarded, the impact was equally significant. In 2019, The Catholic Foundation awarded more than \$34 million in the form of 2,100 grants to over 660 Catholic and non-Catholic organizations across the nation.

The historic performance reflects the community-wide impact of many people who share a common passion about charitable giving.

Sadly, we lost several of our most philanthropically minded, longtime donors to The Catholic Foundation last year. Those individuals had a special place in their heart for a number of organizations that they requested be beneficiaries of funds they created at The Catholic Foundation. The impact of their generosity will benefit others for years to come.

The past year also involved the facilitation of several complex major gifts including gifts of closely-held stock. In those cases, The Catholic Foundation's ability to assist donors in creating impactful charitable plans contributed further to the strong annual performance.

The increasingly popular Donor Advised Fund that provides donors with the ability to recommend which organizations can benefit from the funds they created added to the strong 2019. Similarly, we experienced a surge in testamentary gifts with individuals seeking to create a legacy with thoughtful estate planning, which will provide funds for the future.

Through their spirit of philanthropy, we have seen the very best in people who intentionally chose to serve others.

This is the essence of the *We Are the Foundation* campaign introduced in 2019 that showcases the collective impact of many people working toward a greater good.

We accomplished many milestones last year, and have positioned the Foundation for several new initiatives in 2020.

At the heart of the outstanding year, we valued the opportunity to be with our key audiences and exchange information about the impact that The Catholic Foundation can have in helping fulfill a charitable vision.

Each touchpoint — be it an intimate breakfast, lunch or dinner or a larger gathering such as our Catholic Foundation Award Dinner, Legacy Circle Dinner, Advisory

Council Breakfast, Trustee Dinner, Advisors Series with estate and wealth management professional advisors, the Donor Mass and reception, Work Of Heart presentations to local Catholic school employees, the spring and fall grant ceremonies, the annual Art On The Plaza contest, or our quarterly Catholic Community Network panel discussions — builds upon one another.

Each gathering helped spur conversation about how the trusted stewardship of The Catholic Foundation can help satisfy our donor's intentions while meeting the needs of the Catholic community.

As our impact deepens, we are telling our story in more ways to showcase the role of The Catholic Foundation locally and elsewhere. In addition to our in-person conversations, our digital and social presence grew exponentially in 2019 and ushered in a wave of people who learned more about how the Foundation can be part of their philanthropic plan.

At the end of 2019, The Catholic Foundation managed more than 470 charitable funds and trusts and managed more than \$220 million in assets.

Although the first half of 2020 has been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, the work of the Foundation remains undeterred. An incredibly dedicated staff has abided by social distancing guidelines from medical and government officials, while responding to the countless needs in our Catholic community and beyond.

Many thanks to the overwhelming response from our donors who never wane when it comes to serving others. By rising to the challenge, all those who have recommended grants to various organizations and causes have helped to produce an all-time high era of grantmaking.

With gratitude, we are very appreciative for the confidence that our donors who work closely with The Catholic Foundation have placed in us to help establish customized approaches to directing their charitable efforts.

Today, our Foundation is strong based upon our community of compassionate people making a positive impact in the Dallas area and beyond.

Looking ahead, we are confident that The Catholic Foundation will continue growing even stronger as we build upon our legacy that serves the here and now, and the future.
