

However, U.S. Treasury rates moved higher for short and long maturities and the short end of the yield curve remained inverted. Total nonfarm payroll employment rose by 261,000 in October, and the unemployment rate increased to 3.7%. Inflation, as measured by the Consumer Price Index, increased 0.4% in October on a seasonally adjusted basis, and 7.7% over the last 12 months. Real GDP within the U.S. increased at an annual rate of 2.6% according to the "advance" estimate released by the Bureau of Economic Analysis to begin the third quarter.

U.S. equities, as measured by the S&P 500 Index, increased +8.1% during October. Non-U.S. equity developed markets were positive for the month returning +5.4% while emerging markets were negative for the month, -3.1%. Within fixed income, the broad market index was also negative for the month, -1.3%.






